

Basic Wire Wrapped Earrings

Basic Wire Wrapped Earrings is a beginner class where you will complete two pairs of earring. Earrings are a fun and fast project, especially great for gift giving! In this class you will learn how to make opened and closed (wrapped) loops, various dangles, connectors, open and close jump rings, create and use head pins, and attach earring hooks.

Note: Feel free to bring more components for making additional earrings. Some students work faster than others and if time allows, we can start on a 3rd pair!

Materials Needed

22 gauge dead soft wire - for both pairs
4 ct. earring hooks - 2 for each pair
2 ct. 8mm matching center drilled beads
(pair 1)
2 ct. 6mm matching center drilled beads
(pair 1)
2 ct. head pins (pair 1)
4 ct. jump rings (pair 1)
2 ct. 10mm matching top or center
drilled beads (pair 2)
2 ct. 8mm matching center drilled beads
(pair 2)

Tools Needed

Round Nose Pliers
Flat or Bent Nose Pliers
Flush Wire Cutters
Bead Board
Polishing Cloth
