

Wire Wrapped Bracelet

Wire Wrapped Bracelet is an Intermediate class introducing the basic skills required for making bracelets and linking components. Component size, shape, and color can provide countless outcomes for your finished piece, making this skill mastery a must for every wire wrapper! These skills can be varied to create many different creations in wire! In this class you will learn how to work on the spool, attach a clasp, dangles, wrapped loops, and make decisions that impact the outcome of your design as well as make adjustments as needed.

Note: Changing the size of your beads, jump rings, or wire gauge can greatly affect the length of your finished project. In this project it is recommended that you avoid changing the size of materials or use caution when making changes. Also, please ensure that the beads you choose are drilled with a diameter large enough to accommodate 22 gauge wire.

Materials Needed

22 gauge dead soft wire

4ct. 8mm bead

6ct. 6mm bead

Clasp of choice

8ct. 6mm Jump Ring

Tools Needed

Round Nose Pliers

Flat or Bent Nose Pliers

Flush Wire Cutters

Bead Board or Work Mat

Polishing Cloth

Ruler or Measuring Tape
